



CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION:

Delegations from participating countries will be composed of a maximum of five (5) representatives:

- Three (3) students (male and female)
- Two (2) National University Sports Federation (NUSF) officials
- Please note that you are responsible for insurance coverage.

FINANCIAL CONDITIONS:

- The participation fee is EUR 70 per person, per day.
- All entries must be submitted via the FISU online accreditation system at <u>accreditation.fisu.net</u>
- Payment instructions will be sent via email in mid-April.
 - A 25% deposit by 1.7.2024.
 - The remaining 75% is due upon accreditation pickup or with first deposit with 25%.

IMPORTANT DATES:

- The Zagreb 2024 FISU World Forum will take place from 27 - 31 August 2024.
- Participants can arrive up to 48 hours before the event (August 25) and stay up to 24 hours after the closing ceremony (September 1).

ENTERING CROATIA:

Croatia, a full member of the Schengen Area and Eurozone since January 1, 2023, offers travelers from member countries border-free movement and easy access to its stunning landscapes and rich cultural heritage.

VISA REQUIREMENTS:

- Citizens of Schengen Area and Eurozone countries can enter Croatia visa-free for stays up to 90 days within a 180-day period, whether for tourism or business purposes.
- For travelers from other countries, visa requirements may vary. Please consult the official website of the Ministry of Foreign and European Affairs of Croatia for the latest information on visa requirements and exemptions.


*Please note that due to the summer season, the visa process may take up to 90 days.

PASSPORT AND IDENTIFICATION:

- Travelers from Schengen Area and Eurozone countries can use their valid passport or national ID card for entry.
- Travelers from other countries should ensure they carry their valid passports.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

Entry requirements can change, so it is crucial to check the latest information on the official website of the Ministry of Foreign and European Affairs of Croatia before planning your visit. Additionally, specific requirements might apply depending on your travel category. To ensure a smooth travel experience, verify your specific situation with the relevant authorities or institutions.



TRANSPORT:

PICK-UP POINTS IN ZAGREB*:

BY PLANE:

Zagreb Airport (Franjo Tuđman Airport) is well-connected to major European cities.

BY TRAIN:

Zagreb's central train station offers connections to major European destinations and other Croatian cities.

BY BUS:

Zagreb's central bus station is a major hub for national and international bus connections.

BY CAR:

Zagreb is easily accessible by car via major highways. (Secured parking near the accommodation.)

* All participants of the forum will have guaranteed transportation from the pick-up point to the campus and back.

Safety: Ranked Europe's safest country at night in 2023.


Emergency: 112 (police, fire, medical)
