

FISU Volunteer Leaders Academy 2021

The FISU Volunteer Leaders Academy (FVLA) is an educational event of FISU that is usually held in the capital of youth and volunteering of Russia, the Summer World University Games city of Kazan.

The mission of the FVLA is to position FISU as a unique international organisation uniting University student of the world, and to develop University Sports in cooperation with National and Continental University Sports Federations (NUSF/CUSF).

The aim of the FVLA is to create an international platform to train future FISU Student Ambassadors to promote university sports values and to assist their respective NUSF/CUSF in the implementation of international, national, and local projects and activities.

DATES:

19-20 June 2021 – introduction session (online);

8-14 September 2021 – main session (offline).

THEME: FISU Student Ambassadors programme

SUBTHEMES: International Day of University Sports (IDUS), Volunteer management, FVLA Alumni programme

Eligibility criteria:

- Be a citizen of the country they represent or,
- Be enrolled in a University (or equivalent) located on the territory of the country they represent;
- Be a student at University (or equivalent) at least aged of 18 and under 25 years of age by 31 December 2021 (i.e. born between 1 January 1996 and 31 December 2003);
- Be ready to take part in the full FISU Student Ambassadors programme from September 2021 to September 2022;
- Prove English proficiency level (at least intermediate level) as the programme is entirely conducted in English;
- Be actively interacting with his/her NUSF/CUSF;
- Participate in FISU events and in sport, cultural and social life aspects of his/her university;
- Have knowledge about the history and vision of university sports and events on national and international levels;
- Be ready to implement an action plan concerning the promotion of university sport values;
- The passport of the participant should be valid at least 6 months after the end of the FVLA (at least until 14 March 2022).

FISU STUDENT AMBASSADORS PROGRAMME

The FISU Student Ambassadors programme was launched at the occasion of FVLA 2018. The main role of the FISU Student Ambassadors is to serve as an important link between FISU and the student communities in their countries, helping to raise awareness about university sports among students.

Upon successfully completing the educational programme all participants of the FVLA may be given FISU Student Ambassador status, which grants them a series of roles and responsibilities:

ROLES:

- Act as a link between students and their NUSF/CUSF
- Promote University Sports values
- Be a role model for students
- Network with other Student Ambassadors

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Help their respective NUSF in their projects and activities
- Organise events, make presentations, conduct interviews
- Attend FVLA and educational sessions during the year
- Spread the word of FISU through social media content

PROGRAMME

EDUCATION The educational programme is the main part of the FVLA. The agenda includes 7 days and features workshops, discussions and contests. International experts in delivering major sport and cultural events and representatives of the upcoming World University Games are invited to speak at the FVLA.

SPORT “Try the Sport” is a programme that allows the participants to keep fit during the FVLA. Every day they are encouraged to team games, sport relay, fitness and morning exercises. During the venue tour, the FVLA participants visit the sports facilities used at top level sport events.

CULTURE During the FVLA 2020, the participants will be able to get acquainted with Russian and Tatar culture, cultural conventions and customs during the city tour and cultural events.

OBLIGATIONS

Organising Committee provides: return flight/train ticket, accommodation, meals, insurance, visa invitation and individual telex number, educational, Sport and cultural programmes

NUSF/CUSF provides: registration in OAS, transfer to the airport of departure, visa related costs

NUSF/CUSF have the right to send a separate application for a second participant who meets all participant requirements. In that case, the NUSF/CUSF will be required to cover travel expenses, visa related issues and pay the participation fee (55 euros per day) committee.
