WATERSKI & WAKEBOARD

1. GENERAL TERMS

The Waterski & Wakeboard competitions shall be run in accordance with the most recent technical rules of the International Waterski and Wakeboard Federation (IWWF), unless otherwise stated. In the event of a disagreement on the interpretation of the rules, the English text shall be regarded as authoritative.

The programme and duration of competitions will be fixed by FISU in agreement with the Organising Committee and the WUC ITC. In principle, the competitions shall last five days and include the following events:

Men & Women

- Slalom
- Tricks
- Jump
- 3-event Overall
- Wakeboard (Boat or Cable)

Team classification

Each country may enter a maximum of 13 participants: 3 officials and 10 competitors with the limitation that no team can have more than 6 men or 6 women. Each country may enter a maximum of 4 skiers in any of the traditional 3-events and 2 riders in each of the wakeboard events.

At the first General Technical Meeting, the Head of Delegation or his/her representative shall confirm and sign the official list of competitors accredited by the CIC.

2. PRE-COMPETITION PROCEDURE

Three months before the Championship, the Organising Committee has the right to collect 25% of the total cost of stay per athlete and official from participating countries.

The draw of order shall follow IWWF regulations.

3. TECHNICAL OFFICIALS

Nomination and Costs

International judges shall be appointed jointly by IWWF and FISU. The Organising Committee shall bear their costs of board, per diem and lodging (from two days before the opening ceremony to one day after the closing ceremony).

Other costs are referenced in the FISU – IWWF partnership agreement.

- 1 scorer (Wakeboard).
